Eligibility

Student must:

1. Be a graduating high school senior from any high school in the five town area of eastern Long Island.
2. Plan to pursue at least a 2-year degree program at an accredited school.
3. Submit a completed application to our Association Scholarship Committee, at the above address by the application deadline.
4. Strong interest in animals outside of school is helpful.
5. Any supporting documents or letters of recommendation submitted with application will be considered.

Determination

1. To be reviewed by our Scholarship Selection Committee and submitted on merit to our Board of Directors for voting.
2. Determination will be made at the May board meeting, held the fourth Thursday of the month.
3. School counselor will be notified the following Monday as will the recipient.
4. If there is no eligible applicant, said scholarship money will be saved until the following year, making either a larger award or multiple awards to eligible applicants that year.

Procedure

1. Application forms supplied to each high school in all five East End towns, for distribution to graduating seniors.
2. The recipient will be awarded the scholarship at our annual scholarship dinner in June. The recipient and her/his parents will be guests of the association at the dinner.
3. Actual monies will not be given until the completion of the recipients first semester of school and proof of passing is submitted to the selection committee.
